Updated filters for Activity Finder

Expanding on Activity Finder filtering options to allow for users to more easily sort and filter activities based on specific criteria.

New filters include: ADDITIONAL Time of Day Included in Membership Day(s) & Time(s) Start Month Duration Duration(s) Monday Included in Single day Membership Anytime Morning (Open - 12 p.m.) Additional filters Start month Start Month(s) Afternoon (12 - 5 p.m.) In Membership January Evening (5 p.m. - Close) Duration February

Why are we doing this?

- Provide more consistency and reusability in our components.
- # Allow the reuse of components outside of the Carnation theme.
- Adaptation of components to additional "color modes" (for instance "Dark Mode", "High-contrast (AAA) Mode")
- Sign Clarify the processes of extending and overriding components.


What is the benefit to my Y?


- Dark mode can reduce eye strain, which can result in increased engagement and higher conversion rates!
- 8 Adding color modes can benefit users with visual impairments or sensitivity to bright light.
- X A majority of users (60-80%) prefer dark mode and choose it on their mobile devices.

"Dark Mode" for the Design System

Dark mode is a feature that changes the color scheme of an application or device interface from the traditional light background to a darker one.
